🔶 VETERAN CANDACE ENGEL ★



In 2008 at 28 years old, Candace found herself struggling to be the good person and mother she knew she could be. Working dead end jobs trying to make ends meet, she knew she wouldn't be able to provide the best life possible for her and her son. Candace decided to do something that had been on her mind since she was 18 but didn't have the chance – she walked into the National Guard Recruiters office and signed up to serve her country. In February of 2008, she signed the papers and took the oath.

A few months after basic training, Candace received the news that her son's father had passed and that she was being deployed to Iraq. Unfortunately, during her deployment, she injured her back resulting in the end of her career in the Army and she served out the remainder of her contract knowing that she would not be able to continue to serve. In November of 2014, she was medically retired.

Over the next few years, Candace received two degrees from Pennsylvania College of Technology but more and more issues from her service became apparent. She was struggling to hold meaningful relationships with people who were most important to her. As time went on, the stress and depression worsened. The battle to hold a professional career and be emotionally available for her son due to the medical issues were overwhelming. Unable to work, the PTSD became unbearable until she found something that gave her purpose. Candace now volunteers for an animal rescue where she fosters kittens and helps with various projects. She has dreams of founding her own animal sanctuary to do what she loves the most.
