Corporal Eric Ditty grew up in Renovo, PA attending Bucktail High School. In 1991, during his senior year, he made the decision to join the Army National Guard. Once Cpl. Ditty graduated from high school and BCT he then went to AIT where he was stationed in Germany from 1993-1995. This is where he gained his Corporal status before moving on to Ft. Hood from 1995-1996. After leaving the Army, Cpl. Ditty worked in Corrections for SCI Rockview until 2000 then started his 11 year career at Quehanna Boot Camp.

In 2005, Cpl. Ditty was unfortunately involved in a car accident. During the accident he suffered injuries in which needed imaging. During the imaging, lesions were found in his brain and on his spine. These lesions would later turn into a diagnoses as Multiple Sclerosis. Cpl. Ditty was officially diagnosed in 2008.

Due to the M.S., Cpl. Ditty has been in a wheelchair for the last three years but that has not stopped him from volunteering and giving back to his community. In his past time, he runs a food truck which he graciously donates his time and material to events happening around the Renovo area. He is involved in several veteran and adolescent non-profits and enjoys beekeeping. He has two sons, James and Ryan whom of which he is very proud of. James has recently followed in his footsteps graduating BCT and becoming apart of the 11th Airborne as a combat medic and is currently stationed in Alaska.
